| When: | Saturday October 10 to Sunday October 11, 2009. Sail from Ling Beach to Emerald Bay, Catalina and back to Long Beach. |
| Event: | <p>This is a 2-day Sail on The Privateer Lynx (http://www.privateerlynx.com/) Lynx is a square <u>topsail</u> schooner based in Newport Beach, California. She is an interpretation of an American privateer vessel of the same name from 1812. The original Lynx played its part in running the British blockade, assisting the then almost non-existent American naval forces, and defending the American coastal waters and merchant ships against the Royal Navy.</p> <p><u>Day 1/Saturday October 10:</u> Leave La Jolla/LJPC at 5:45 a.m. Saturday the 11th, arrive Long Beach for training by 8:00 a.m., setting sail for Emerald Bay, Catalina by 9:00 a.m. Anticipated arrival (winds permitting) by 3:00 p.m.</p> <p><u>Day 2/Sunday October 11:</u> Leave Catalina 9:00 a.m. Sunday arrive Long Beach approximately 3:00 p.m. travel to La Jolla/LJPC and arrive 5:30 p.m.</p> |
| Location/ Activities: | <p>We have reserved spots for 20 participants; we may have an opportunity for more but this is not guaranteed. You will learn about sailing in the educational presentation in the morning and on the sail over to Catalina and back.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon arrival at Emerald Bay, Catalina, BSA Camp) at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday we will settle into cabins and then the Troop will take a 2+ hour hike into the hills surrounding Emerald Bay. Diner will be provided in Camp (no cooking!) • Sunday morning you will have free time after breakfast. Boat leaves at 9:00 a.m. |
| Time: | Be at La Jolla Presbyterian no later than 5:30 a.m. for arrival in Long Beach at 7:30 a.m. We will return at 5:30 p.m. Sunday. |
