

# RIFLE SHOOTING SAFETY ORIENTATION & INSTRUCTION EVENT

## SATURDAY - DECEMBER 12, 2009

---

**WHEN:** Saturday, December 12, 8:15-1:15 PM. Troop 4 Scouts are asked to arrive at the Project 2000 Shooting Range by 8:15 a.m. for check-in and equipment distribution.

**WHERE:** Project 2000 Shooting Range, 2082 Willow Glen Drive, El Cajon, 92019. This facility has several indoor and outdoor shooting ranges for rifle, pistol, shotgun and archery. Our Scouts will use a 20 yard outdoor range for this Event. See [www.project2000range.com](http://www.project2000range.com) for more information, photos, and details about their "Junior Safety & Shooting Program" which the Scouts will complete.

**MERIT BADGE:** ***REQUIREMENTS:*** Scouts who plan to earn the Rifle Shooting Merit Badge **MUST:** 1) Read the Pamphlet; 2) Complete the attached Worksheet on or before this Event, and; 3) Achieve minimum accuracy requirements at the Event.

**LOCATION/TIME/ACTIVITIES:** **Scouts and parents who wish to car pool should meet at 7:15A.M. in front of La Jolla Elementary on Girard; we will depart at 7:30 A.M. sharp and return about 2:00 P.M.**

After checking in at the Range Pro Shop and receiving safety equipment (eye and ear protection), Scouts will receive two hours of instruction in safety procedures, responsibility, discipline, and marksmanship. The course instructor and 2-4 assistants will use lecture and video presentations and actual firearms demonstrations before the Scouts are allowed to fire .22 caliber single shot rifles under their supervision.

A BBQ lunch will be prepared and served by the Scouts from 11:00AM - 12:00PM. Both indoor and outdoor lunch areas are available on site.

From 12:00 - 1:00PM, our Scouts will have exclusive use of the Rimfire Gallery, a nine-station range with pop-up and moving targets. Each Scout can fire up to 50 rounds each on this Range. Parents can also shoot with rented .22 rifles (\$10) or bring their own .22 but must use "standard velocity" rounds (available for \$3.15 per 50 cartridge box).

Car Pool drivers will depart Project 2000 at 1:15PM to arrive at La Jolla Elementary at about 2:00PM. Scouts can keep their earmuffs and eyeglasses for future use and all participants receive a ONE YEAR MEMBERSHIP at Project 2000 which includes discounts for range use and special events.

**THE COST:** \$30 for Scouts; \$10 for adults. **PAYMENT IS REQUIRED BY OCTOBER 12TH.** Includes .22 rifle use; ammo; earmuffs and eye protection; two hours instruction; shooting gallery with 50 rounds; soft drinks and BBQ lunch.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO WEAR:** Class A or B Uniform. Long sleeve shirts and jackets are recommended for cool weather. Comfortable, closed toe walking shoes or boots.

**WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING:** Sunscreen; jackets and gloves for warmth since we will be outdoors. Extra money for Pro Shop purchases if desired.
